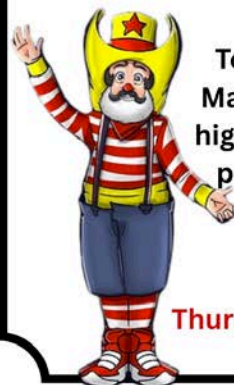

Livestock trailers will enter through the pit area and line up for the veterinary check. Animals to be weighed must arrive during their specific time frame. 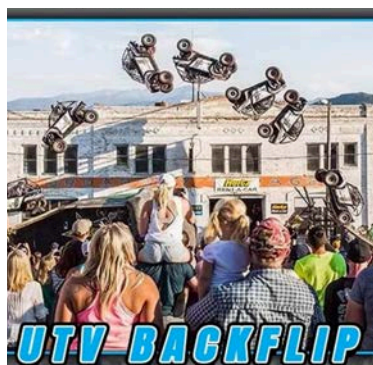
